A new well was installed about 18 months ago. This winter has been a bit of a challenge, but it seems to be running well now. The bathrooms are heated and seem to be keeping warm enough not to freeze (an added bonus to not having port-a-potties).

Many of the ranges have been improved! The 200 yard range has a new chimney on the woodstove courtesy of Jefferson State Shooting Association Youth Club and will be getting more work done this year. Courtesy of the National Rifle Association, the berms have been corrected and a better drain system was installed. The competition range has received numerous improvements also. It is not yet complete, but has made lots of progress. The anticipated completion date is summer of 2017. Shotgun enthusiasts will note that there are new scenarios for the upcoming season. The 600 range got its retaining wall and walk way cemented in.

Cattle have been used at the park for weed abatement and fire safety. They caused a bit of a problem on the Flightmasters' deck, but that was resolved with some fencing and support from the cattle owner.

The motorcycle track has also been receiving some remodeling and more will come in 2016.
